Kackaamin Family Development Centre is an Indigenous-led, not-for-profit treatment centre that runs 24/7, 365 days per year. We require a custodial staff to join our team:

- Shifts: as-needed shifts based on site use (evenings, weekends), session turnaround, and downtime cleaning

Tasks

- Sweep, mop, scrub and wax hallways, floors and stairs
- Empty trash cans and other waste containers
- Wash windows, interior walls and ceilings
- Clean and disinfect bathrooms, kitchens, and other office and residential spaces and fixtures
- Work with minimal supervision
- Perform minor repairs on appliances
- Take

- Perform safety and security checks
- Move heavy furniture, equipment and supplies
- Perform other routine maintenance jobs such as painting and drywall repair
- Water and tend to plants, lawns and/or gardens
- Clean snow and ice from walkways and parking areas
- Make adjustments and minor repairs to heating, cooling, ventilation, plumbing and electrical systems, and contact tradespersons for major repairs
