Kackaamin provides family treatment services for individuals of all ages with a focus on building a healthy family attachment, trauma healing, and addictions recovery. RTC is an extension of KFDC and provides an intensive therapy program to address intergenerational traumas related to sexual violence. RTC Programs include Healing Sessions for Those Who Have Been Harmed, Restoration Sessions for Those Who Have Harmed Others, and Family Systems Interventions.
